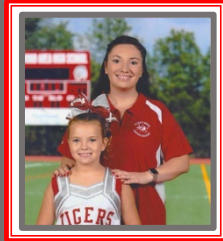


MEET THE BOARD

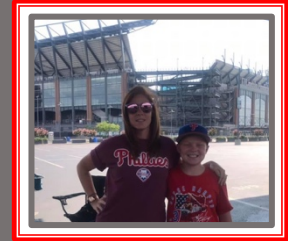
PRESIDENT – Alexandria (Alex) Peters
